

## **PINA MEETING February 2 2022 Part 1**

**1:Call To Order 7.30pm:** Directors present via Zoom; Kevin Pistor, Veronica Zehntner, Agnes Provost, Gerald Halabura, Ken Pepperdine, Richard Gafney, Jane Garcia.

Guests: Corinne Brolevicz, Anne Millington, Christina Nichol

We acknowledge we are holding this meeting on the ancestral, traditional and unceded territory of the Snuneymuxw First Nation.

2: Anne Millington addressed the directors; Anne updated us that there has been an application submitted at the City from Mr Tura, to purchase a section of Spyglass Lookout that extends in front of her property, for the purposes of building a residence there. Anne had also submitted an application to purchase it and envisioned this area being a boat and kayak storage area for other residents to use and to access the water there. Anne's proposal was that PINA inquire about the possibility of leasing this area for the boat/kayak storage.

3: Corinne Brolevicz addressed the directors; Corinne asked if PINA would be willing to participate in making sure the community is made aware of the application to purchase Spyglass Lookout.

Directors were able to ask questions and clarify any points made by both guest speakers.

## **Part 2**

### **Call to order at 8.15**

Discussion ensued regarding PINA and the request for a community education campaign regarding the purchase of the roadway, and the possible designation of it as an unused roadway for this process.

Kevin noted that the Neighbourhood Associations were to be notified by the City of any upcoming changes or applications such as this, but we have not received any notification.

The board decided that more information from the City is needed to determine the following:

Is Spyglass Lookout to be sold

What is the process for selling public lands such as roads or parks.

What is the process for disclosure of this type of application

What constitutes an Unused Road designation

Two directors will inquire further at the City Real Estate Dept -Ken and Gerald- and Kevin will also speak to a contact at the City.

PINA will hold another meeting as soon as information has been gathered. The next step would then be to facilitate a community meeting with the City to provide information.
